Describe the central dogma of molecular biology.

As a general rule, the classic view of central dogma of biology reflects how molecular biology data are organized within the databases (e.g, by molecule type such as genomic DNA, mRNA, protein). However, many exceptions to this dogma are now known as a result of genomic studies in recent years.

flows from a DNA sequence to a protein product inside cells.

Thus, the Central Dogma of molecular biology is invalid as an "absolute" principle: transfer of information from proteins (and specifically from protein sequences) to the genome does exist.
