A dangling modifier is a phrase or clause that either modifies no word in the sentence or refers to the wrong word. Dangling modifiers cause the sentence to lack coherence .

Because of this separation, the meaning of the sentence is often awkward, ridiculous, illogical, or confusing.

Sometimes writers use modifiers incorrectly, leading to strange and unintentionally humorous sentences. The two common types of modifier errors are called misplaced modifiers and dangling modifiers.

Misplaced and Dangling Modifiers - lardbucket

A dangling modifier is a phrase or clause that modifies a word not clearly stated in the sentence, or that does not connect grammatically with what it is intended to modify.

Dangling modifiers are so called because they are modifiers (usually adjectives) that do not obviously and logically refer to a word or phrase in the sentence, or to a noun or pronoun in the form that it appears in the sentence.

A modifier gives a description about a word or phrase, such as how green describes grass in the phrase "green grass." While single word modifiers are commonly adjectives or adverbs, nouns and verbs may also act as modifiers, as in "snow bank" or "swimming hole."

A dangling modifier has no logical word to which it refers. In the most common cases, dangling modifiers involve verbal phrases at the beginnings of sentences. Immediately after these phrases, the logical reference must be provided.
