Polychaetes as a class are robust and widespread, with species that live in the coldest ocean temperatures of the abyssal plain, to forms which tolerate the extremely high temperatures near hydrothermal vents.

As polychaetes are soft-bodied animals, their fossil record is sparse. However, the Dorvilleidae have well-developed jaws that are well represented as scolecodonts, starting in the Early Ordovician (Rouse and Pleijel, 2001) and closely resemble modern-day boring species.

Nephtyid polychaetes dig with their pharynx and are commonly found in muddy sand, although some species live in clean sand; they are carnivores or selective omnivores [7]. Antarctic polychaetes have a much higher percentage of unique species than polychaete faunas in other parts of the world [2].

Polychaete species richness and abundance dramatically dropped under the extreme low pH conditions due to the disappearance of both calcifying and non-calcifying species. Differences in distribution patterns indicate that the decreasing pH modified the structure and biological traits of polychaete assemblages independent of changes in habitat.

Polychaetes are well represented in most marine and estuarine environments, both in terms of number of individuals and species, and they typically contribute a significant percentage of the total macrofaunal diversity.

Polychaetes represent one of the dominant taxa in benthic marine communities including Antarctic waters where they can account for more than 70% of macrofauna (organisms retained in a 300µm sieve) [25,26] with recorded abundances of more than 300 individuals per 0.1m² [27].

These segmented worms are among the most common marine organisms, and can be found living in the depths of the ocean, floating free near the surface, or burrowing in the mud and sand of the beach.
